

Multiple Medical Tourist (C-3-3)

Eligibility

A person who is visiting Korea for medical treatment or recuperation at a medical institution and needs to visit the country multiple times for the same purpose

The persons who are applying for the first time must be able to prove the situation as guided by the "Visa Finder."

The persons who already hold multiple medical tourist visas must be able to present clear evidence of having received medical treatment in Korea.

※ Those who are believed to be engaged in employment activities will be restricted.

- 3-year multiple visas: 1-year multiple visa holders who visited Korea more than twice and did not violate any regulations during the stay.
- 5-year multiple visas: 3-year multiple visa holders who did not violate any regulations during the stay.

※ The eligible persons can apply for 3-year and 5-year multiple visas a month before the expiry date of the visa that the person is currently holding (Example: if your current visa expires on January 31, 2022, you can apply for 3-year or 5-year multiple visas from January 1, 2022)

Every citizen and resident of Mongolia who wants to enter the Republic of Korea with Medical Tourist Multiple visas must apply through the Korea Visa Application Centre. Note that you can apply for a multiple-entry visa, valid for 1-year, 3-year, or 5 year with the maximum duration of stay for 30 days.

Note that the Embassy may request additional documents if it is deemed necessary for the evaluation of the visa.

Patients who require over 30 days of stay according to the medical records, etc.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. Original invitation letter from a Korean hospital;
Original confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in the Korean hospital;
Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital; and
Copy of the proof of registration of the Korean hospital as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.
2. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5x4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
3. Passport in original and a copy
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days from the application date)

5. A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia

- The certificate must include that the patient requires over 30 days of stay for treatment, etc.

※ Authorized hospitals in Mongolia: National Trauma and Orthopedic Research Center, National Cancer Center of Mongolia, The First, Second, Third State Central Hospitals, Intermed Hospital, Grandmed Hospital, and UB Songdo Hospital.

6. Proof of financial means and Certificate of Employment

- **Business owner:** Tax payment certificate (at least MNT 400,000/quarter, more than 6 months passed after being designated as the owner)
- **Employee:** Confirmation of payment of social insurance (monthly base salary of at least MNT 1,000,000 for the past 6 months)
- **Other cases:** Bank statement on the name of the applicant for the past 6 months (*Joint accounts are not accepted)

※ The bank statement must be submitted in summary.

※ The above documents must prove that the applicant can afford the cost for treatment and stay in the country.
