

SHORT TERM NEWS COVERAGE (C-1)

ELIGIBILITY:

- A person who plans to engage in reporting or news coverage in Korea, that has been dispatched to the branch office for a short time, within 90 days of stay;
- A person who plans to engage in reporting or news coverage in Korea and is sent by a foreign firm, for a short time, within 90 days of stay;
- A representative of media firms who plans to establish a Korean branch office.

Every resident of Mongolia, who requests a visa to enter the Republic of Korea with a Short-Term News Coverage visa must apply always through the **Visa Application Centre**. Note that you can apply for a single-entry visa (maximum duration of stay 90 days), for a double-entry visa if you can prove the need of a second entry to Korea within 6 months (valid for 6 months with the maximum duration of stay of 90 days). The Korean Diplomatic mission can ask for additional documents.

COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm color picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy
3. Marriage Certificate
 - FOR MINORS (below 19 years of age): Birth Certificate (submit a copy of parents' identity card if the date of birth of the parents is not recorded on the birth certificate)
4. Dispatch letter
5. Proof of employment or Press card (International press card)
6. Copy of Business Registration Certificate
