

STUDY VISA (D-2): ASSOCIATE DEGREE (D-2-1), BACHELOR’S DEGREE (D-2-2), MASTER’S DEGREE (D-2-3), DOCTORAL DEGREE (D-2-4)

ELIGIBILITY:

A person who plans to enroll (associate degree to doctoral degree) at an academic research institute, or a community college (undergraduate or graduate) or above.

Every resident of Mongolia who requests a visa to enter the Republic of Korea with a Study visa must apply through the **Visa Application Centre**. Note that you can apply for a single entry visa valid up to 2 years. Mongolian visa applicants must provide and submit to the Korea Visa Application Centre the original of the highest degree certificate and the transcript that will be returned with the passport when the decision-making process is finalized.

The Korean Diplomatic mission can ask for additional documents.

COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), 60 USD of visa fee. One 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy.
3. Self-Introduction form in original (in MS Word or Hangul) using the official form of the ROK Embassy with signature
4. Certificate of admission and Business Registration Certificate of the Korean institute
5. proving the financial capacity to cover the expenses in Korea*.
 - **For students at institutes in the Seoul metropolitan area (Seoul, Incheon, Gyeonggi-do province):**
Balance of USD 20,000 for the past month
 - **For students at institutes in other regions:**
Balance of USD 18,000 for the past month

The minimum amount must be maintained on each of the days of the month of the provided bank statement and must be maintained during the whole process of the visa decision making.
Spouse cannot be a sponsor. Only if he or she works in Korea legally can sponsor it.

 - Confirmation letter for expenses coverage from the sponsor
 - Copy of the ID card, proof of relation
 - Confirmation of support for study abroad expenses and certificate of employment
 - Proof of monthly income of the person who pays for study abroad expenses (Social insurance card, tax payment certificate)
6. Marriage Certificate (issued in the past 45 days)
7. Certificate of criminal record (issued within the past 45 days (over 18 years old, first time visitor))
8. Tuberculosis test result from an authorized hospital**
9. Original and photocopy of the highest education degree certificate***
***Diplomas issued before 2018 and issued by private institutes must be duly Apostilled.
10. Proof of language skills****
****Language competencies required:
Korean Language – Technical/Vocational College: TOPIK level 3/Sejong Institute’s level 5 (Intermediate 1)
Korean Language – Universities/Graduate Schools: TOPIK level 4/Sejong Institute’s level 6 (Intermediate 2)
English Language – TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, IBT 71), IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, TEPS 600
