

## SIMPLIFIED VISA CRITERIAS

### ELIGIBILITY

Short term General (C-3-1), Ordinary tourist (C-3-9), Medical tourist (C-3-3), Business Visitor (C-3-4)

### VISA TYPE (Visa validity/Duration of stay)

Single-entry visa (S): 3months/90days; Double-entry visa (D); 6 months/90days

Please note that even if the criteria are met, the visa can be denied if it is deemed possible to illegally stay or commit illegal acts in consideration of past violations, immigration, and residence conditions. Note that the Embassy may request for additional documents if it is deemed necessary for the evaluation of the visa.

**Please choose the criteria that met with your situation and submit required documents.**

### **A. A person invited to take part in events such as seminars, short courses, and friendly competitions organized by the State Administration (by the central administrative agencies) and local authorities**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Official letter from mutual country authorities  <b>Mongolian side:</b> Introduction of the inviting authority, event agenda, sponsor details and attendee list, employer letter, social insurance book copy, social insurance payment verification (if paying)  <b>Korean side:</b> Event agenda, travel expense (flight ticket, accommodation sponsoring details etc.), attendee list, business entity certification (copy of registration certification), Inviter details to be shown at entry
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

### **B. A person with an invitation from a South Korean authorized international organization (international organizations authorised by the Government of ROK)**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Official letter from mutual country authorities  <b>Mongolian side:</b> Introduction of the inviting authority, event agenda, sponsor details and attendee list  <b>Korean side:</b> Event agenda, sponsoring party (flight ticket, accommodation sponsoring details etc), attendee list, business entity certification (Copy of registration certification), inviter details to be shown at entry
4. A certificate of employment, a copy of social insurance certificate, a payment confirmation of social insurance fee, etc.
5. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**C. A diplomatic passport holder who is travelling with the purpose of tourism, medical tourism and visiting family relatives using the regular passport**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Documents proving eligibility: A copy of Diplomatic/Official passport (valid at least 3 months), a certificate of employment
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**D. Who meets the requirements of the Multi entry visa (1.A-M) and who used to have Multi entry visa**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Documents proving eligibility: copies of passport visa pages and immigration stamps
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**E. Visa exempt (Frequent entrants or a person with frequent entry records, a person who travelled to Korea more than 10 times in which 4 times within the last 2 years)**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Documents proving eligibility: copies of passport visa pages and immigration stamps
4. Family relation certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**ø Excluding the previous E9, E10, C4 holders**

**F. A person who travelled to more than 2 OECD countries or travelled more than 3 times to one of the OECD countries (excluding visa exempt countries for Mongolians and Koreans)**

Countries where Mongolian citizens can travel without a visa: Israel, Turkey and Chile

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Documents proving eligibility: copies of visas and immigration stamps of the OECD countries (expired old passports to be submitted in original)
4. Family relation certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**G. A person who has visited Korea at least 2 times in the last year for business and whose business performance with Korea is proven**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Proof of existing business with Korea
4. Copies of visas and immigration stamps
5. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

**H. A parent, grand-parent, or child of a person who has acquired Korean nationality and a parent, grand-parent, or child of a spouse of a Korean national (F-6)**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
4. Family relation certificate
DOCUMENTS FROM INVITER
1. Invitation letter (original): ROK Embassy invitation form <b>Korean national:</b> personal stamp on the invitation and to attach copy of personal stamp certificate <b>Korean national residing in Mongolia:</b> guarantee letter of return (ROK Embassy form)
2. Copy of identity card: residence card, driving license, passport, or alien registration card
3. Marriage status or family relation certificate of ROK

**I. A parent, grand-parent, or minor child) of a resident with F2 visa or his/her spouse and a parent, grand-parent, or minor child of a permanent resident F-5 person or his/her spouse**

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months
2. Passport in original and copy
3. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
4. Family relation certificate

## DOCUMENTS FROM INVITER

1. Invitation letter (original): ROK Embassy invitation form

**Korean national:** Personal stamp on the invitation and to attach copy of personal stamp certificate (When the original seal certificate is attached to the invitation letter – notarization is not required)

**Mongolian national:** submit an invitation letter and an invitation consent form from a Korean spouse)

2. Copy of identity card: residence card, driving license, passport, or alien registration card

3. Marriage status or family relation certificate of ROK

∅ If a Korean spouse applies for a visa to live with an inviter, it is classified as F6.

∅ If a long-term residents, permanent residents, spouses and children apply for a visa to live with the inviter, it is classified as F-1 / F-2.

J. A parent, grand-parent, or minor child of a D5, D6, D7, D8, E 1 to E7 visa

## COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months

2. Passport in original and copy

3. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

4. Family relation certificate

## DOCUMENTS FROM INVITER

1. Invitation letter (original): ROK embassy invitation form: Notarized invitation (Reason of inviting and guarantee of return should be in the content of the invitation)

2. Copy of identity card, a certificate of employment.

\* Investment (D-8) should attach company certification copy, reference for tax payment

K. Spouse, minor child and grandparent of an applicant eligible for C to G conditions of simplified visa

## COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa application form (Form 17), one 3.5x4.5cm photo in color, taken within the last six months

2. Passport in original and copy

3. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

4. Family relation certificate
